To All Staff, Residents, and Visitors:

As of today, we currently have 3 residents who tested positive for COVID-19. All 3 residents were in the quarantine unit as they were new admissions to our facility. The 3 residents have been isolated to a separate portion of the facility. All residents and staff who had contact with the 3 residents are being tested and monitored for COVID-19.

COVID-19 is increasing in the community. If you have not received a booster vaccine, we recommend that you receive one. We are continuing to offer the booster vaccine for residents and a large percent of our long term care residents are up to date with their COVID-19 vaccine. Please also be mindful of your mask wearing, especially around residents. As a reminder, all visitors must be wearing a mask at all times while inside the facility. Residents do have the option of not wearing a mask, but we highly encourage them to. If you see visitors, vendors, staff, or students not wearing a mask, please remind them to wear one.
